

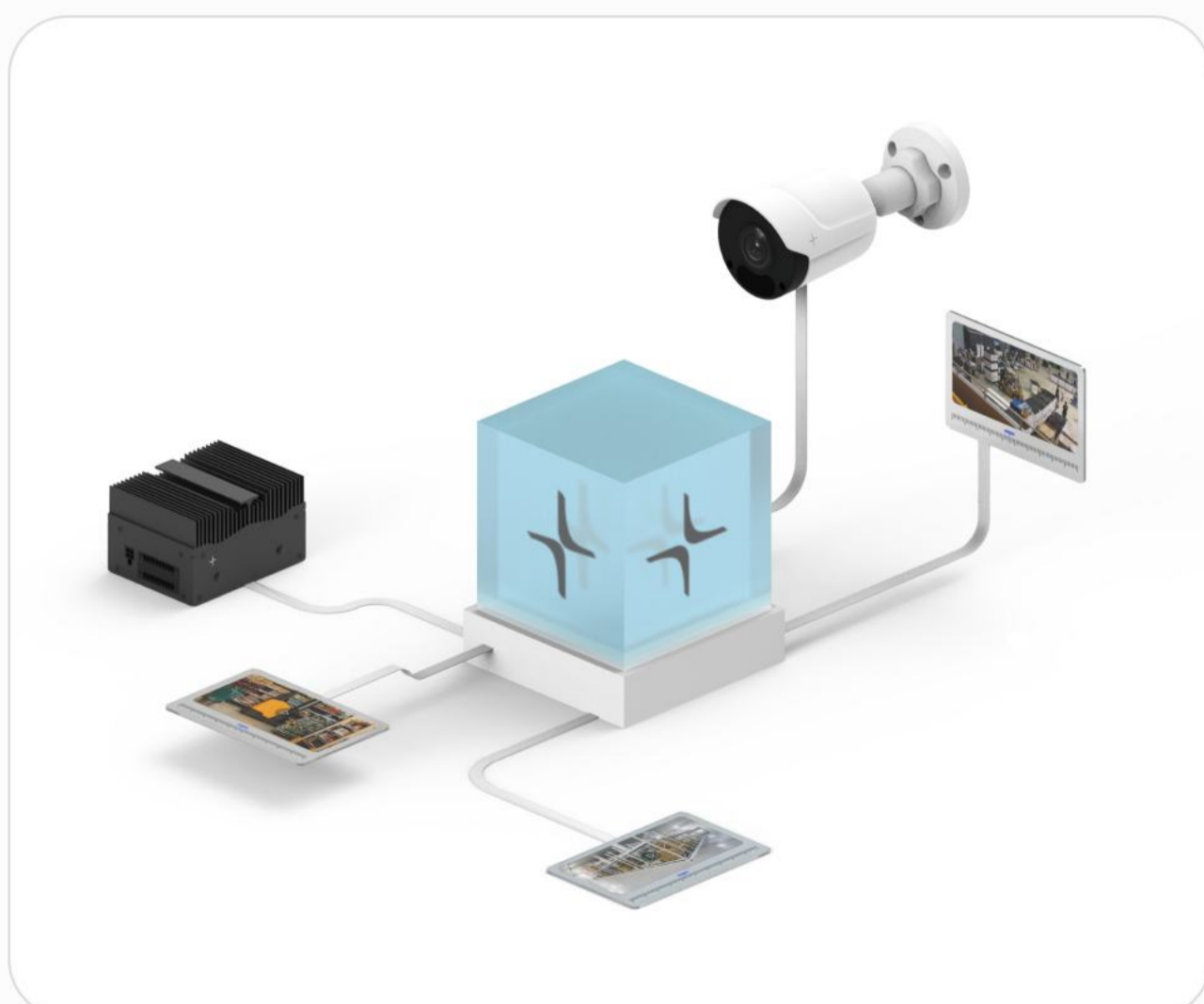
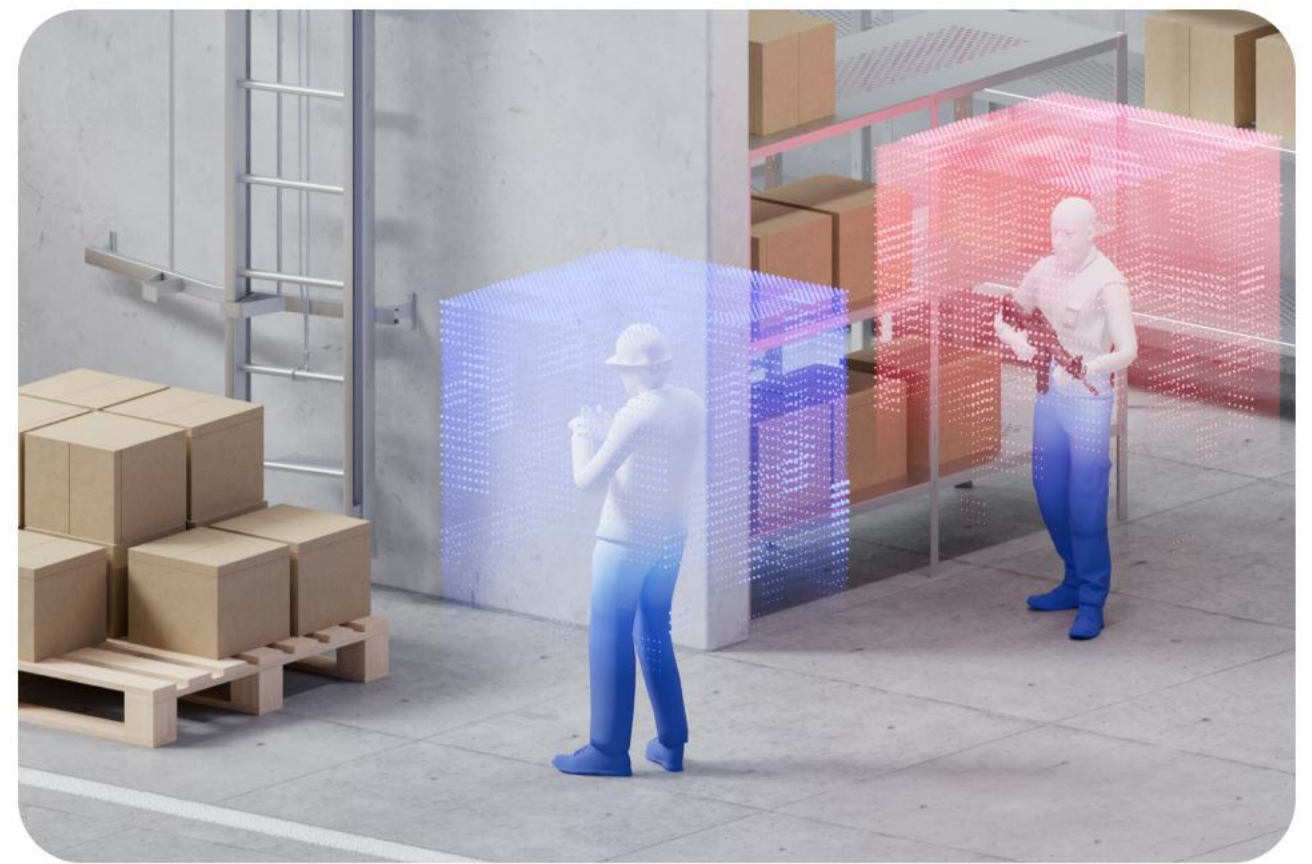


How to Choose the Best Enterprise AI Video Security System: Evaluation Checklist

However, with so many options claiming AI capabilities, how do you determine which solution is best from a video security and AI performance standpoint?

FACTOR ONE

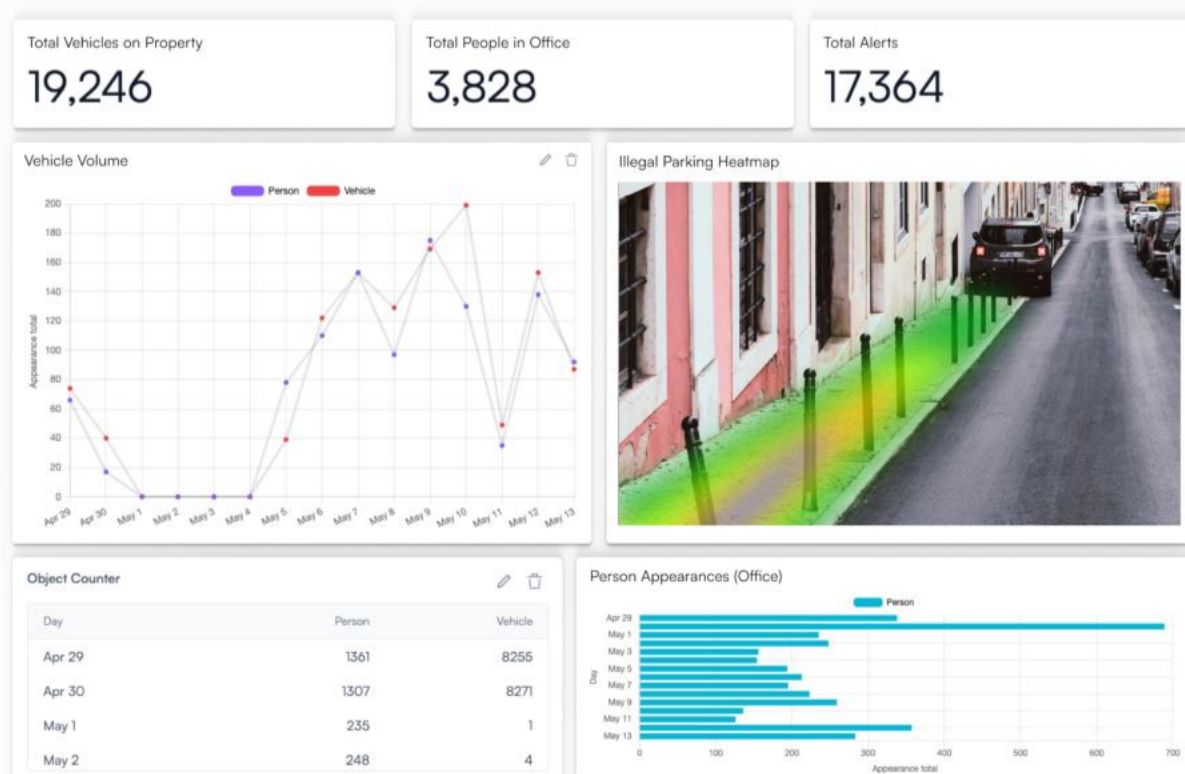
Accuracy and Performance

- Are the AI models built in-house?**
Most vendors use AI from third parties. It's best to find a solution where the AI is developed in-house.
- Is the AI processed using a hybrid approach?**
AI can be processed on-premises, in the cloud, or hybrid-cloud. Hybrid solutions tend to perform better.
- Does the solution use GPUs for AI?**
Using dedicated GPUs enables better AI processing power, performance, and accuracy.
- Can the AI detect people and vehicles?**
Any new video security system should detect these objects at the bare minimum.
- Can the AI detect specific activity and behavior?**
To fully utilize AI video security, the system should understand and detect unwanted activity/behavior.
- Is the AI accurate more than 80% of the time?**
70-80% is the industry benchmark for basic AI detection. Conduct control tests to determine accuracy.

FACTOR TWO

Integration Capabilities

- Is the system camera-agnostic?**
Selecting an AI solution that works with existing cameras reduces complexity and costs.
- Does the system have open APIs?**
Open APIs enable integration capabilities to deliver more value than just video recording and viewing.
- Can you centrally manage the system?**
Having the ability to manage all hardware, locations, and users from one platform is critical.



FACTOR THREE

Advanced Analytics and Features

- Does event detection happen locally?**
Events should be processed locally for immediate detection. Pushing to the cloud will slow processing.
- Is the vendor AI-focused with their product?**
If you want the best AI performance, select a vendor that prioritizes visual AI vs hardware creation.
- Is the AI self-learning?**
Unlike static models, self-learning AI models update based on your environment in real time.
- Do AI alerts trigger in real-time (<1 second)?**
Test the latency and alert speed. Most video security systems encounter delays between 5-10 min.
- Are AI alerts highly customizable?**
Alerts should offer advanced customization to identify critical events without manual monitoring.

FACTOR FOUR

Data Management and Security

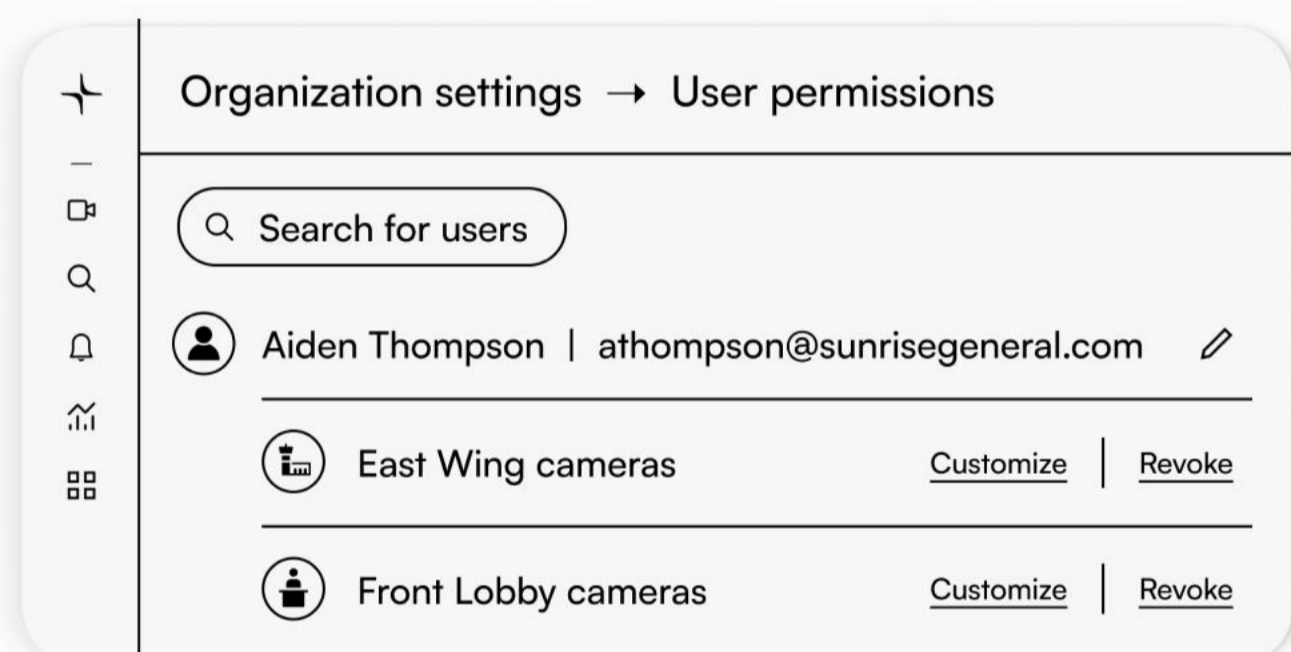
- Is enterprise-grade cybersecurity standard?**
Hybrid-cloud architecture, end-to-end encryption, and auto updates provide complete peace of mind.
- Is it NDAA and SOC2 compliant?**
At the bare minimum, the system should follow NDAA and SOC2 for data privacy and protection.



FACTOR FIVE

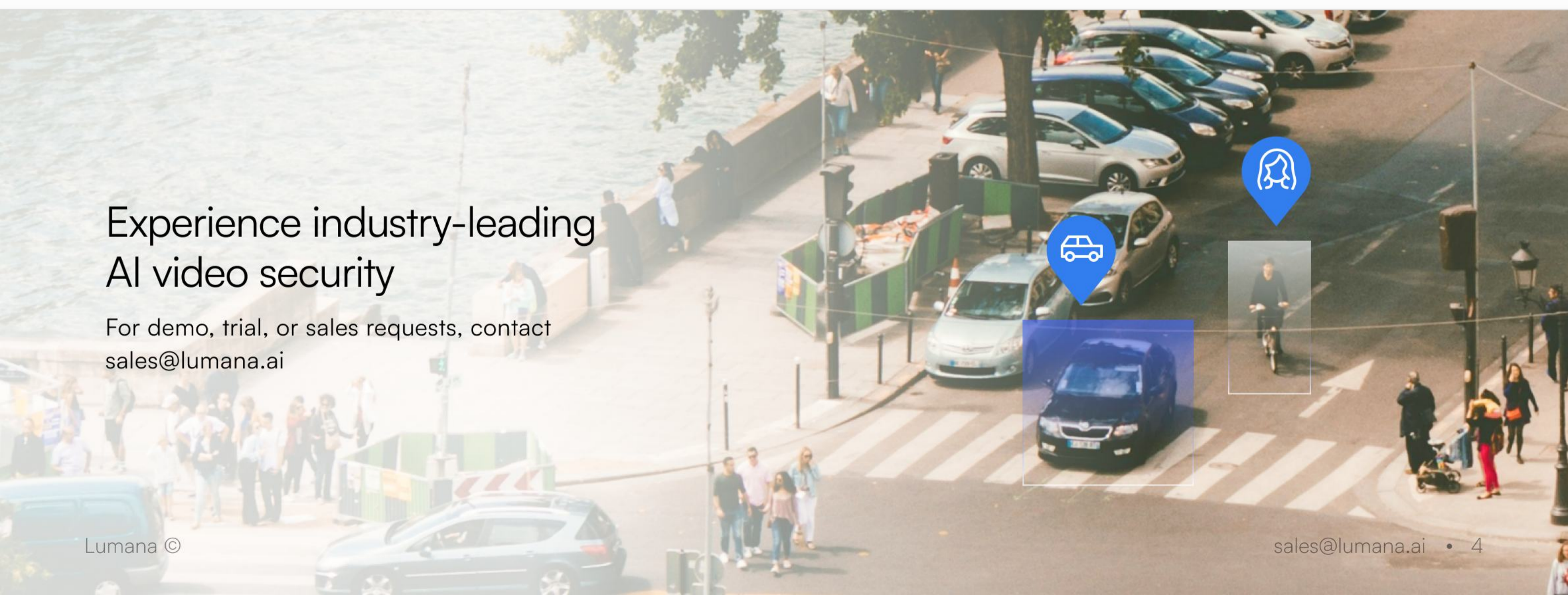
User Interface & Operational Ease

- Can you access the system remotely?**
Web browser and mobile access reduces the burden of going on-site to view footage.
- Is the software intuitive and easy-to-use?**
An easy-to-use solution will deliver more value and ROI than an overly complex one.
- Is customer support based in the US?**
US-based customer support is critical in troubleshooting and overall user experience.
